THE ISSUE:

Sex trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation (CSE) occur every day, right here in St. Louis.

- St. Louis is ranked as the 16th top city for human trafficking in the United States.
- 75-95% of individuals involved in the sex trade were sexually abused before age 18.
- 40% of homeless LGBTQ individuals are victims of commercial sexual exploitation.
- Every survivor served by Healing Action has experienced sexual violation, many for the first time as children, resulting in substance use, mental health issues, post-traumatic stress, depression, anxiety, homelessness, and incarceration.

HEALING ACTION

OUR MISSION:

Healing Action partners with survivors and the community to end commercial sexual exploitation. We do this through community awareness, client advocacy, and a comprehensive array of services.

WHAT WE DO:

Healing Action is doing extraordinary things to bring hope to survivors of sex trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation in the Saint Louis area. To date, we have served over 290 survivors and actively serve between 50-70 survivors. Healing Action provides services such as:



CASE MANAGEMENT

Helps ensure that basic needs are met through assessment, planning, facilitation, care coordination, & advocacy.



TRAUMA THERAPY

Supports survivors in their process of growth and healing through individual & group counseling and group psychoeducation.



PEER SUPPORT

Provides support groups and one-on-one coaching sessions led by a certified peer specialist who serves in the role of a mentor.



DROP IN CENTER

Offers a safe, comfortable space where clients can rest, do laundry, and utilize computers for resource & job search.

2021 MILESTONES

- Provided services to 118 survivors - including helping 61 survivors obtain and maintain safe housing.
- Provided 2158 hours of Intensive Clinical Case Management and 746 hours of Trauma Therapy.
- Provided transportation assistance (gas cards and bus passes) to 43 survivors.
- 82 survivors achieved a personal, self-identified goal, such as getting a job, moving into an apartment, going back to school, maintaining sobriety, etc. Overall 216 goals were achieved.
